

Insider Secrets About Sampling That Samplers Should Know

If you currently smoke, then it is impossible to not know about the dangers of smoking and the laws that restrict the ability of samplers to enjoy nicotine in public. You might even have thought about trying to give up smoking because of the health implications.

You are probably aware of e-cigarettes the electronic cigarette replacement that gives the enjoyment of tobacco without the harmful side effects. Sample Copy or vaporizer pens are the latest development of e-cig technology.

Unlike normal cigarettes nothing is burned and there's no ash, instead there's a heating element that heats up a concentrate that can contain nicotine and flavorings that are delivered to the user in a cloud of water vapor. Unlike cigarette smoke the water vapor disperses in seconds without leaving smelly and sticky residues. Sample Copy are more advanced than e-cigs and there are some significant enhancements, not the least being that in an e-cig there's always nicotine but in a vape pen the nicotine is optional and can be substituted with 'herbal' products or nothing at all, just flavouring.

Differences Between Sampling and Smoking

The biggest single difference between smoking and sampling is the health issue. There's little doubt that sampling is simply much less harmful than smoking cigarettes. The vaporization process destroys the harmful by-products associated with smoking tobacco. Even setting aside the carcinogenic effects of smoking cigarettes, when you are doing physical activity smoking gets in the way leaving you breathless and coughing. Sampling does not have that effect. Now you can enjoy tobacco without it getting in the way of your life.

Sampling is less messy than smoking with no ashtrays, no smoke residues on walls and ceilings and no nasty smells on clothes or soft furnishings.

Smoking a cigarette is not quite the same as smoking a vape pen and this is something to consider when moving over to sampling. The draw on a vape pen can feel quite different to that from a cigarette so it is worth looking out for a vape pen that has a tight draw similar to the cigarettes you have been using. Better yet, a pen with a variable draw system allows you to choose the setting that suits you best. Samplers will be interested in two bits of jargon:

- Mouth to lung inhaling

This is where the air flow is relatively low, similar to the draw on a cigarette and with a similar level of flavour to cigarettes. This type is often a good choice for people moving from cigarettes to sampling as it feels and tastes much the same as what they are used to.

- Direct lung inhaling

This mode has a much higher air flow, lots of vapor and more flavour. This mode is what more experienced vapers tend to prefer.

Some vaporizers can offer both modes with different settings or heater coils.

Differences Between E-Cigs and Vaporizer Pens

Sample Copy are a more recent entry to the electronic smoking market and although both offer the experience of 'smoking' without burning the raw material there are some important differences and the market seems to be moving very much toward the new technology. The table below outlines the differences and shows why you will almost certainly want to use a vape pen.

What Should You Be Looking For In A Vape Pen

1. Quality and durability

As with many things we buy you do tend to get what you pay for. Many people who are seriously into sampling will spend over \$100 but if you are getting started then spending in the region of \$50 is likely to get you going without losing a load of money if you don't get into the vape scene. Stay away from unlikely looking bargains and check user reviews before buying.

2. Genuine product

If a reputable brand vape pen is sold at a very low price, then counterfeiting may be an issue. In general, avoid buying from auction sites such as eBay or from the Chinese mega e-stores. Stick to sites such as StaySmoking.com who carefully vet their suppliers. Knock-offs are likely to fail and have no warranty protection; possibly worse, they may give a poor sampling experience that could put you off sampling for ever.

3. Concentrate compatibility

Unlike e-cigs, Sample Copy can use different types of concentrate. Some Sample Copy can cope with e-liquid (oil), waxes or dry herbs. Other types can work well with only one or two of these. If you are undecided about which type of sampling you will prefer then look for a model that works with all three. It is worth remembering that the most popular form of concentrate is oil (e-juice/e-liquid)

4. Appearance

Most vaporizers are tube shaped although some tend toward the boxy. When you look over the different types of vape pen it is likely that you will prefer one style over another. As you will be using the pen quite often it is important that you should enjoy the aesthetics of the unit

5. Features

As the sampling market expands there's a growing range of product features to choose from but all work by heating the concentrate to produce a water vapor which is drawn from the mouthpiece by the user.

Sample Copy heat the concentrate by either conduction or convection. In the first the heating element contacts the concentrate and in the other the concentrate is heated by warm air. You may be attracted to units that have temperature displays or a one-touch activation feature. Heavy users will be interested in the battery size or amount of concentrate held in the unit.

The Choice Of Concentrates

Unlike the older e-cigarettes a vaporizer can use many different types of concentrate. You should take care to use the right kind of concentrate for your unit or you might damage it and will certainly have a less than perfect sampling experience.

Your vaporizer can use Herbal or dried herbs, some are meditative and will stimulate and energize your mind, others are more relaxing with a calming, soothing effect.

Next there's vape oils often called e-juice or e-liquid. This is the most popular form of concentrate. [E-juices](#) can have a range of flavors running from standard tobaccos through to fruits, foods (caramel, chocolate etc.) and herbal flavors.

Lastly there's waxes or gels with a similar range of flavorings as the oils.

Sampling Accessories

When you buy your first vape pen you are going to need to get some additional items. For example, if you use herbal products in your vaporizer then you will need a [grinder](#) so that you get the finest particles possible. A fine grind enables you to pack more herbal product into your pen and into your storage container.

For sure you are going to want to get the right cleaning tools to make sure that your pen is always ready to work efficiently.

Many users find that batteries never last long enough. On the upside, many manufacturers supply extended life batteries, they may increase the size of your pen but for most users that's a worthwhile compromise.

Of course you will be wanting to buy concentrates to enable your sampling pleasure. There's thousands of types and flavors to try out and choose as your favorites.

Buying Your First Vape Pen

There's many places who want to sell you your first vape pen, they understand that you will tend to return to them for future purchases. Many people are finding that buying online is their best option because local retailers are often expensive and carry only a small range of products. Online stores such as [Stay Smoking](#) try to be a one-stop shop offering a good range of genuine products at excellent prices where you can buy a starter kit, accessories, e-juices and even related paraphernalia.
